

ZfD – Regulations for the Submission of Manuscripts

The *ZfD – Zeitschrift für Diskursforschung (Journal for Discourse Studies)* is subject to a double anonymous peer-review procedure. Manuscripts may be submitted in either German or English and should not exceed a total length of 60,000 keystrokes inclusive of spaces. (In exceptional cases deviations from this length are possible after agreement with the editors.) An electronic version should be submitted as either a Word file (or as a Open Office file). The manuscript texts themselves should bear no indication of the name(s) of the author(s). Every manuscript should be accompanied by a short Abstract. Receipt of every text will be acknowledged. If a manuscript should be accepted, notification will also be given. When a manuscript is accepted the following further requirements should be observed:

- 1.) Every article should be accompanied by an abstract in both German and English (and this should include a translation of the title). Abstracts should be between 600 and 800 keystrokes in length.
- 2.) The final version of every article must be sent in electronic form (in Word format) to the email address of the editors (zfd@phil.uni-augsburg.de).
- 3.) Tables should be incorporated directly in the text and should have a breadth of either 11.3 or 9.3 cm. Please do not incorporate illustrations, diagrams and graphics directly in the text document but save them to a separate file in the relevant format (using the graphics functions of MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint, or other graphics programs such as Photoshop).
