

Travel to Perpignan with French lessons

This workshop is geared towards providing participants with some fun French language learning online. Had you been in Perpignan, you could have bought a bus ticket in French, say, or had a coffee with croissant in the historic city centre; you could have visited the Palace of the kings of Majorca, done some sight-seeing, visited beautiful Collioure...

The workshop, run by two Masters students at the University of Perpignan, is intended to make up for the lack of Frenchness in the online conference format.

There are two levels on offer: beginners French (for real beginners, who don't really know any French) and what we've called 'rusty French' (for people who learned French at school maybe or who have some basic skills but have forgotten or not practiced much).

The aims of both levels are to equip participants with some useful French for visiting Perpignan and the region (from the Mediterranean coast to the Pyrenees mountains). A range of activities will be used, including some data-driven learning (and hopefully some hands-on corpus use for the more advanced group).
